

What is Shepherd's Maternity House?

Started in 2008, Shepherd's Maternity House is a home that is operated by the Social Services of the Diocese of Scranton. Located in East Stroudsburg, it provides shelter, care, counseling, job training and education to



expectant mothers. Up to 8 mothers and their infants can stay in the home for as long as 18 months. After the birth of her baby, a mother will also receive help in securing housing, employment, or continuing her education, as well as any other support she may need. 
